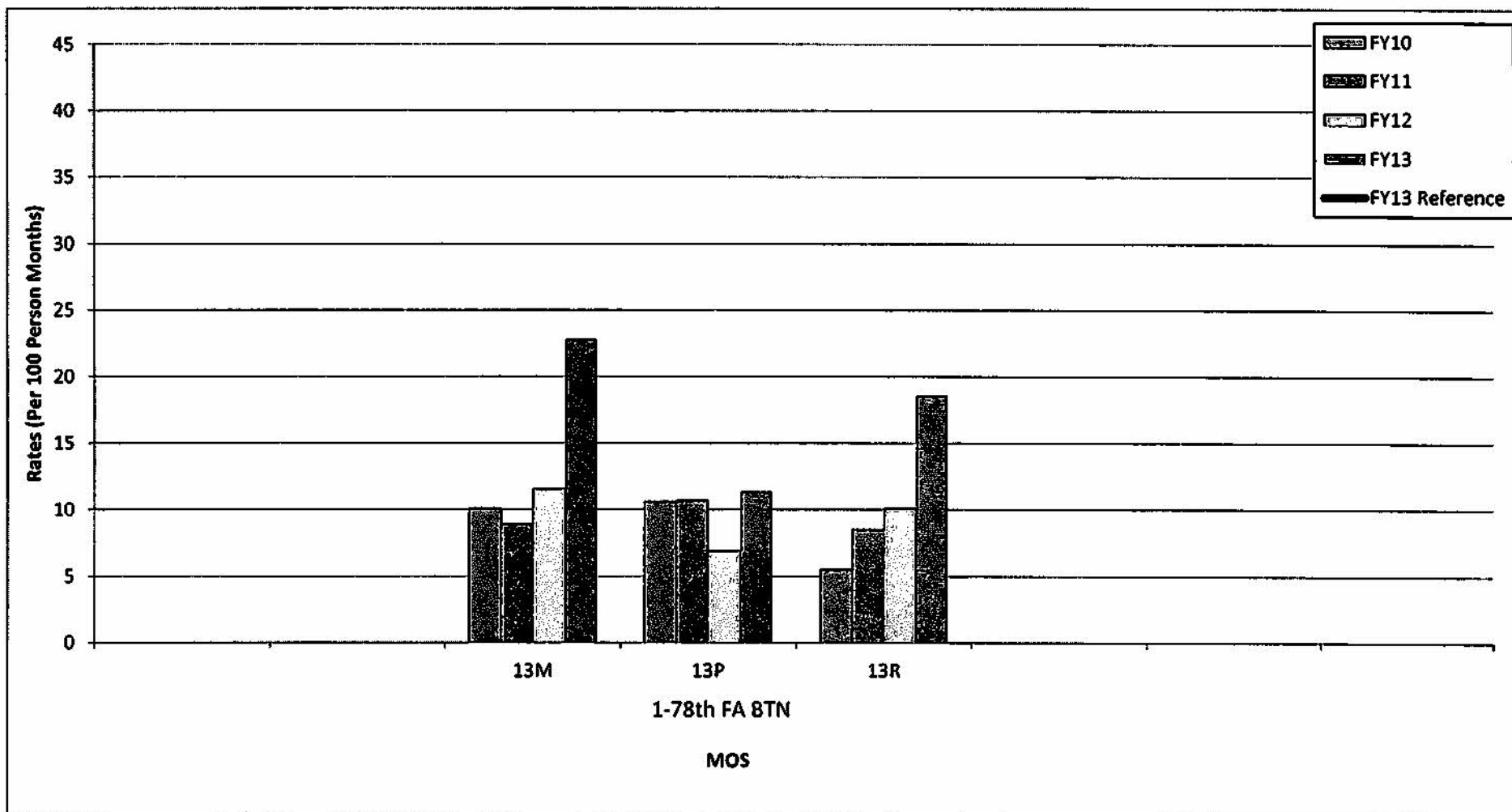

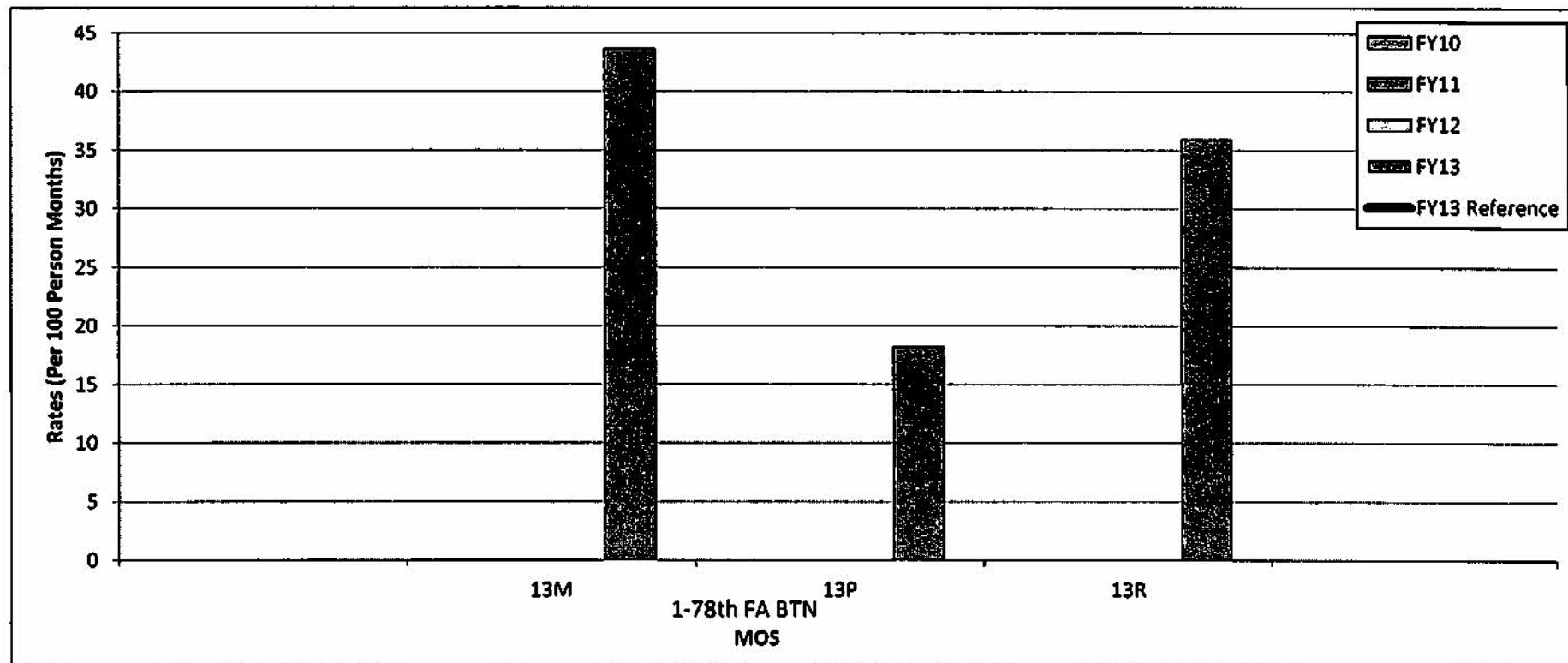
Field Artillery AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS (Injuries per 100 person-months)



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Field Artillery AIT Women: Injury Rates for 13T (Injuries per 100 person-months)



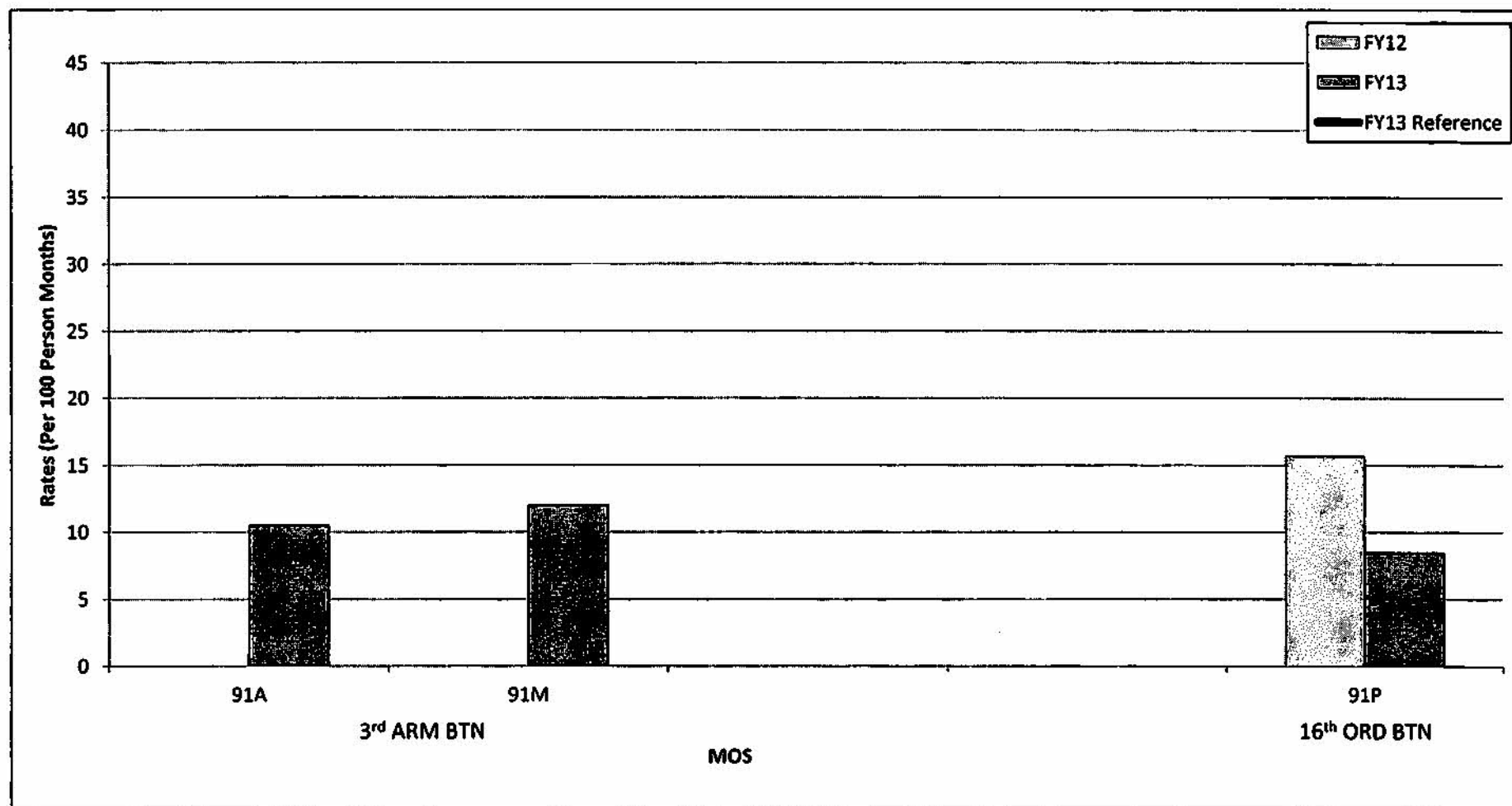

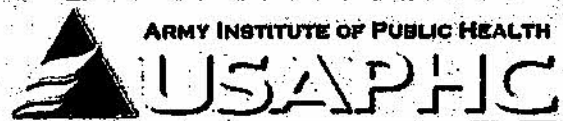
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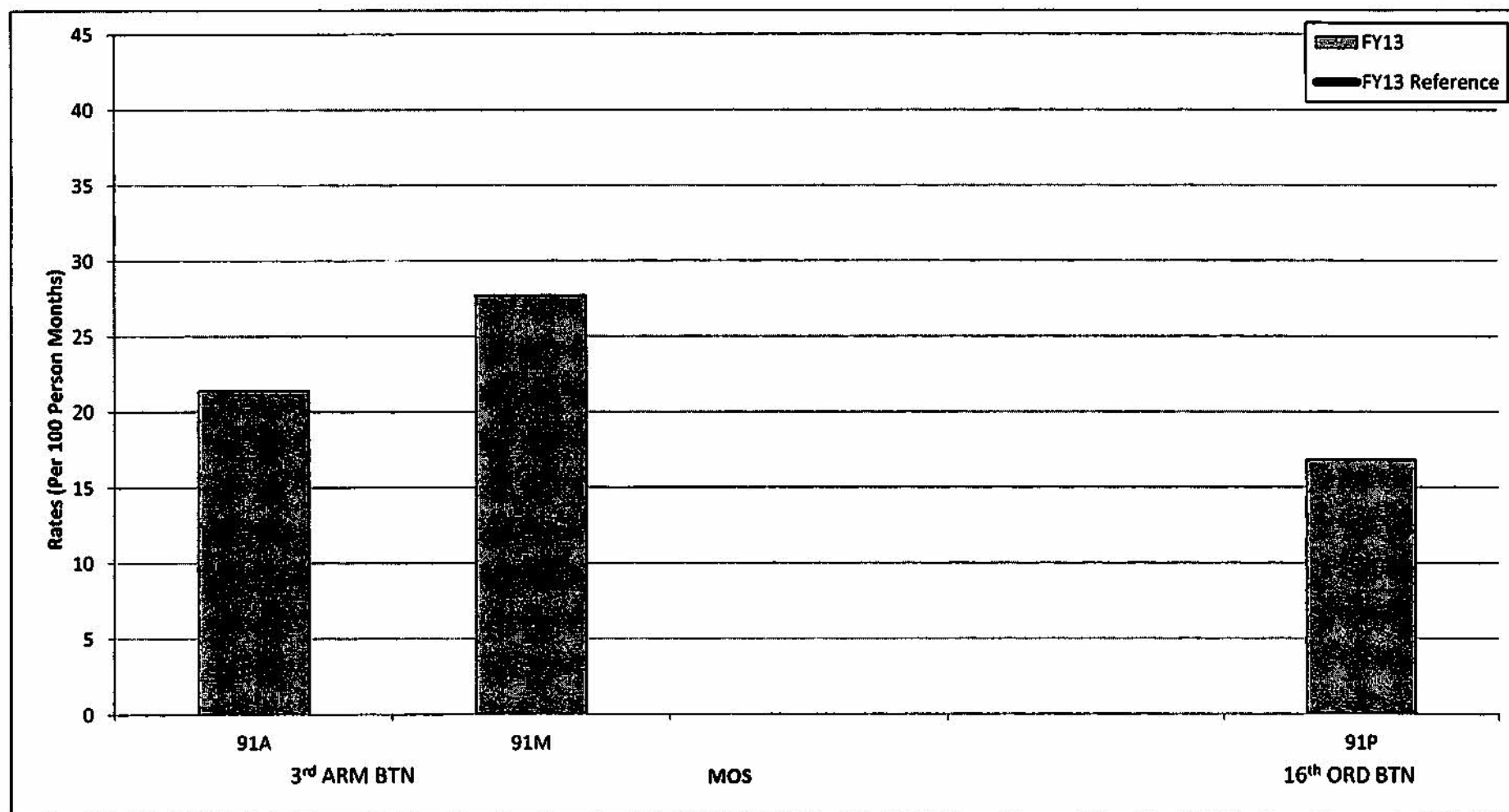
Armor and ORD AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS and Battalion (Injuries per 100 person-months)

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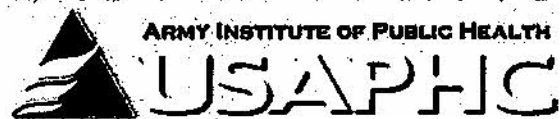

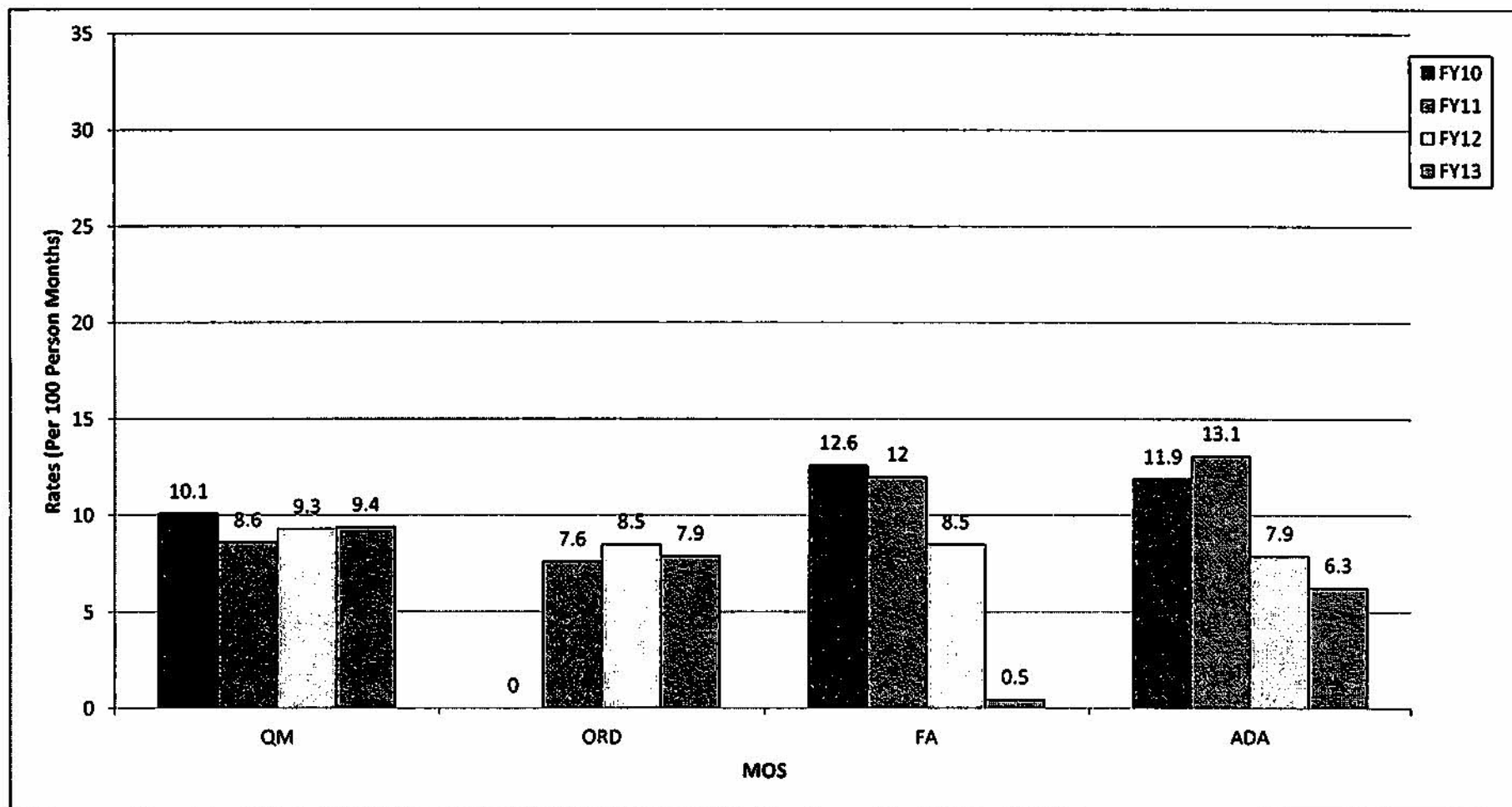


AIT Injury Rates for FYs 10, 11, 12, and 13

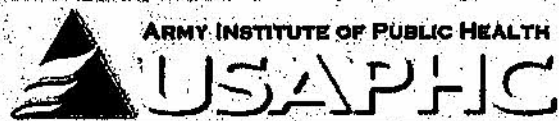

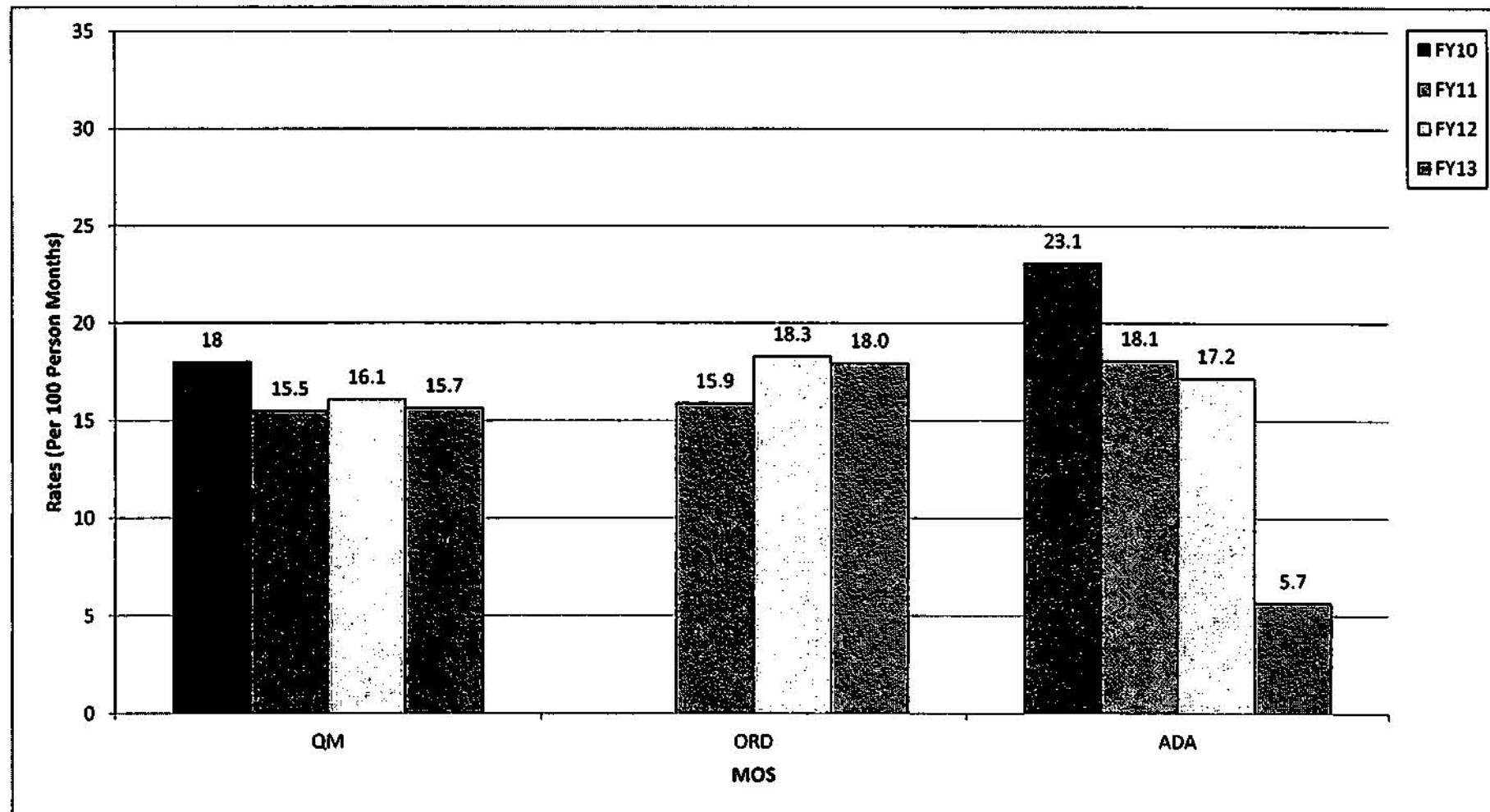
Entry-level AIT Men: Injury Rates by School (Injuries per 100 person-months)



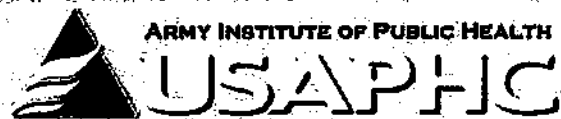
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Entry-level AIT Women: Injury Rates by School (Injuries per 100 person-months)

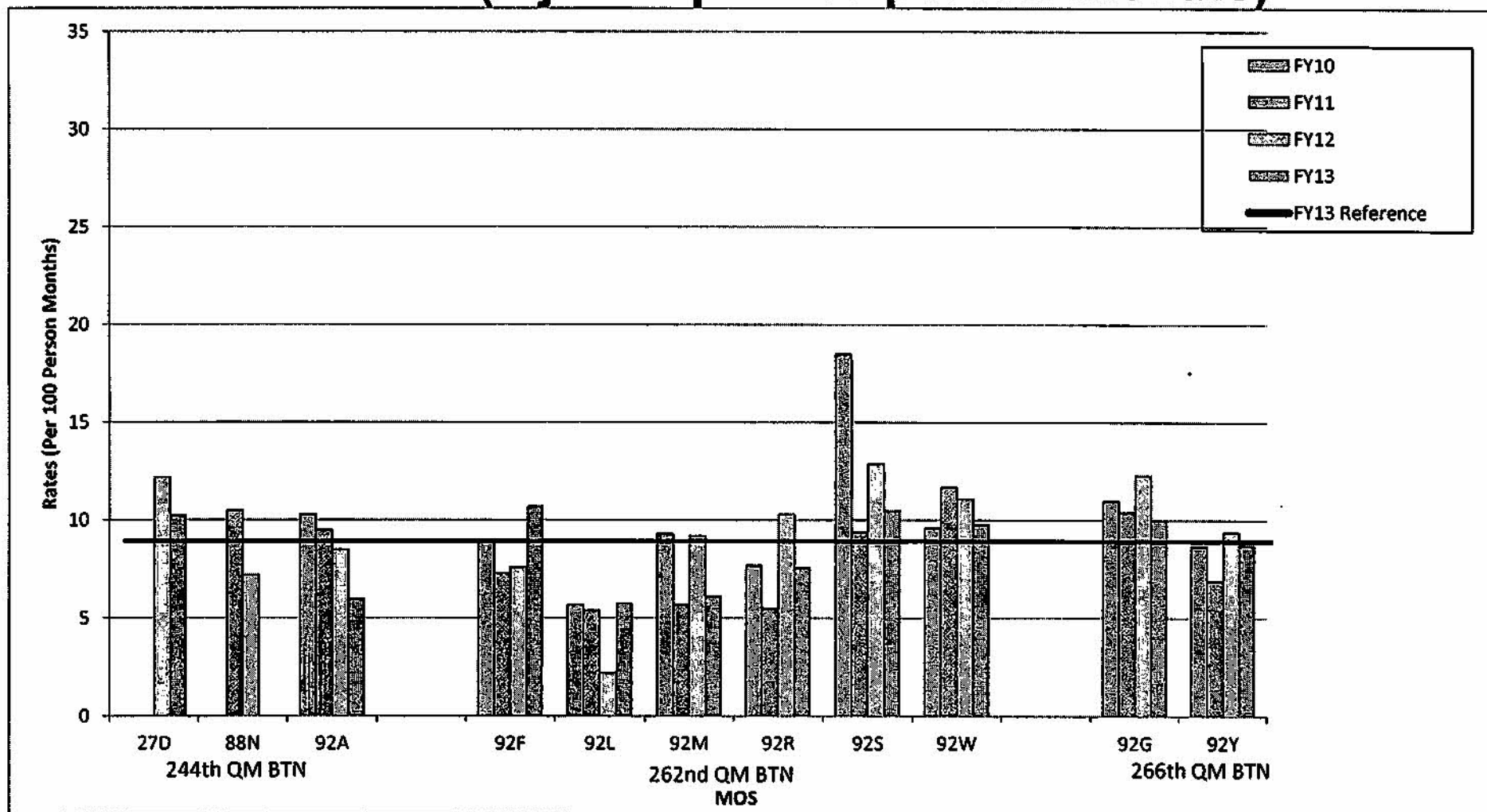

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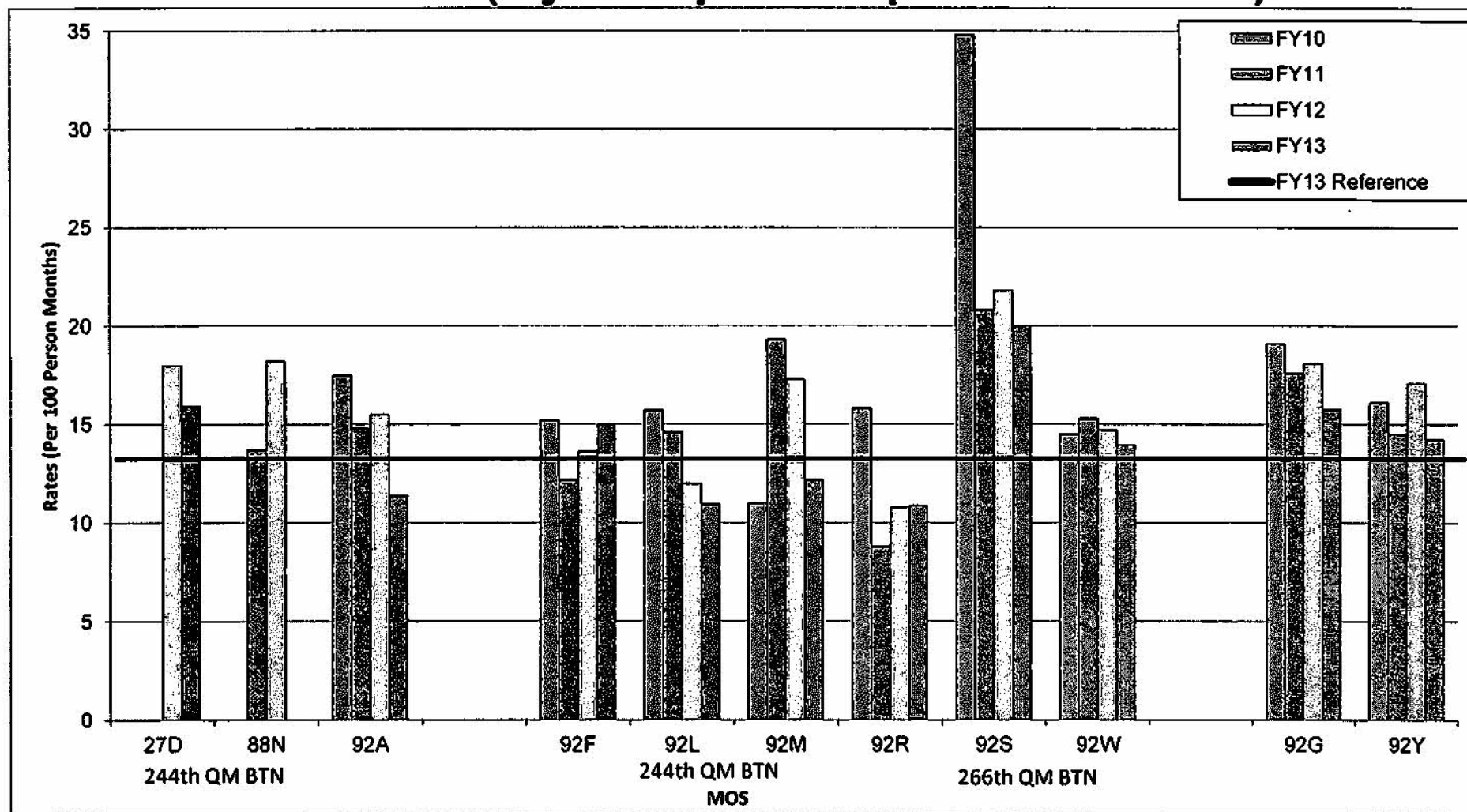
Quartermaster AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS and Battalion (Injuries per 100 person-months)

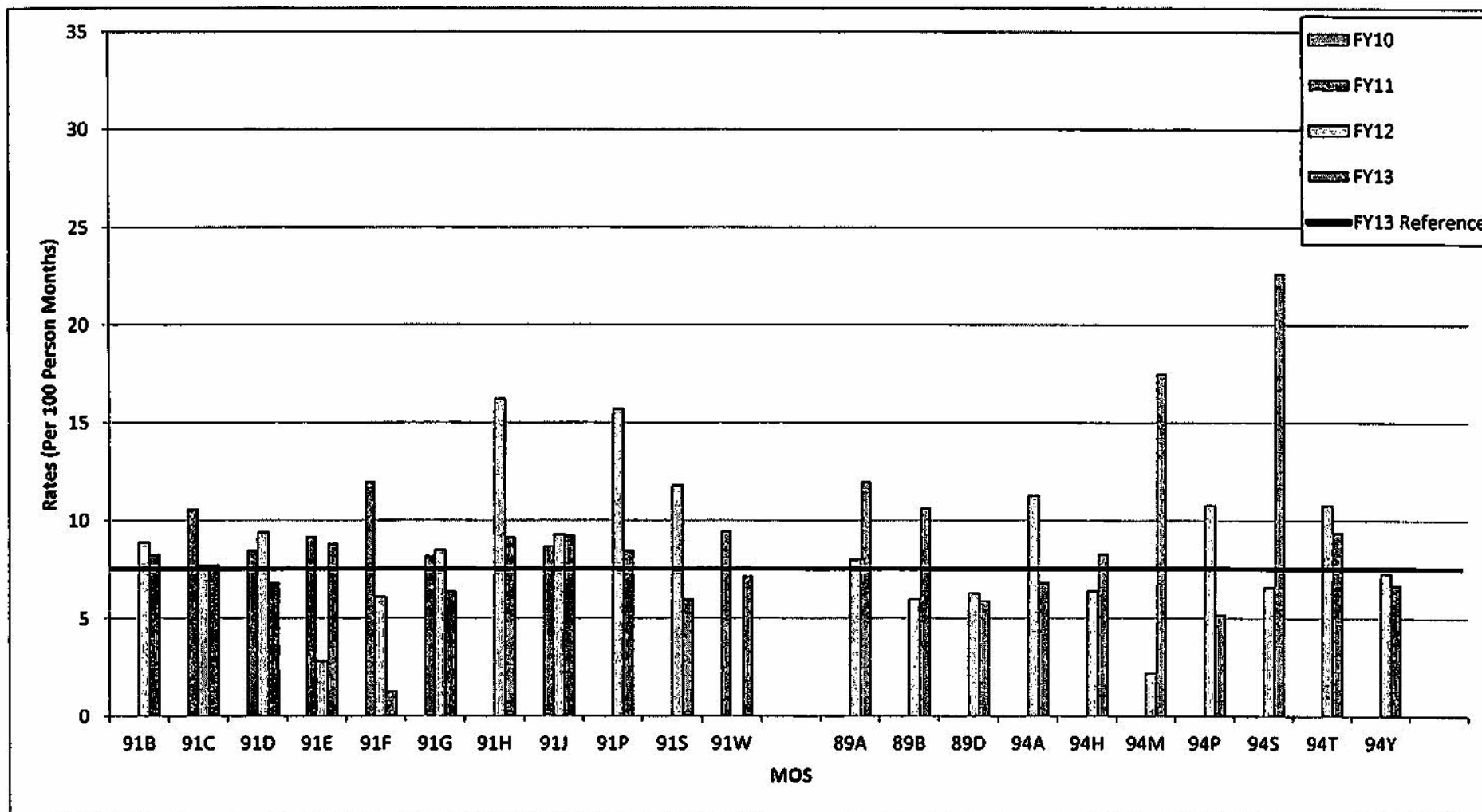

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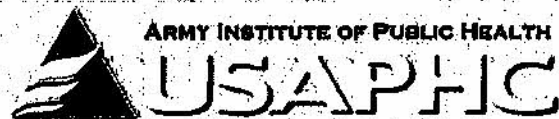


Ordnance AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS and Battalion (Injuries per 100 person-months)

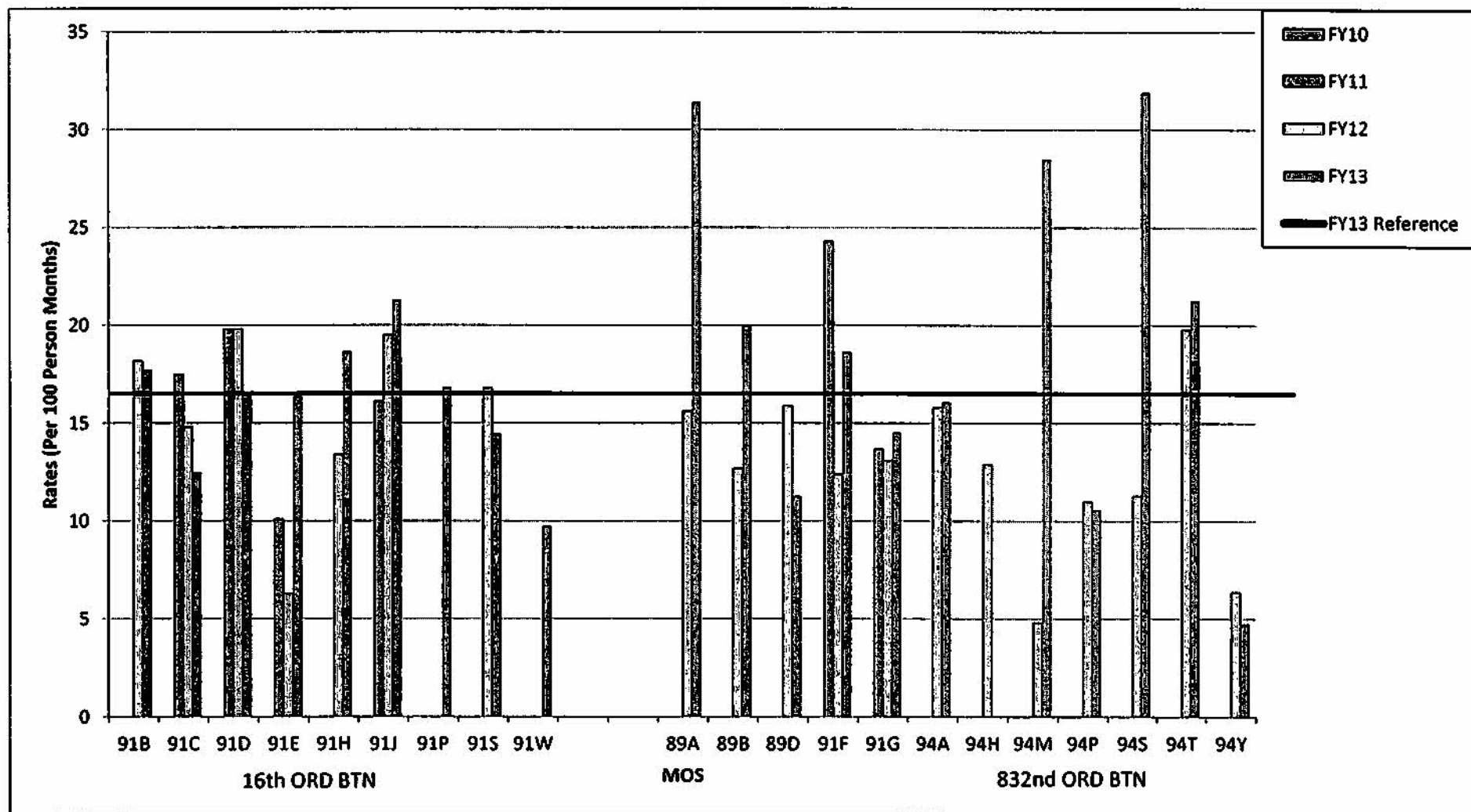


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ORD Women: AIT MOS Injury Rates (Injuries per 100 person-months)



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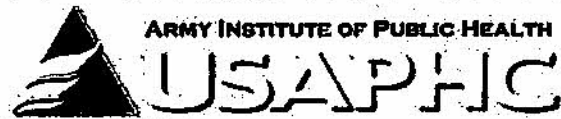

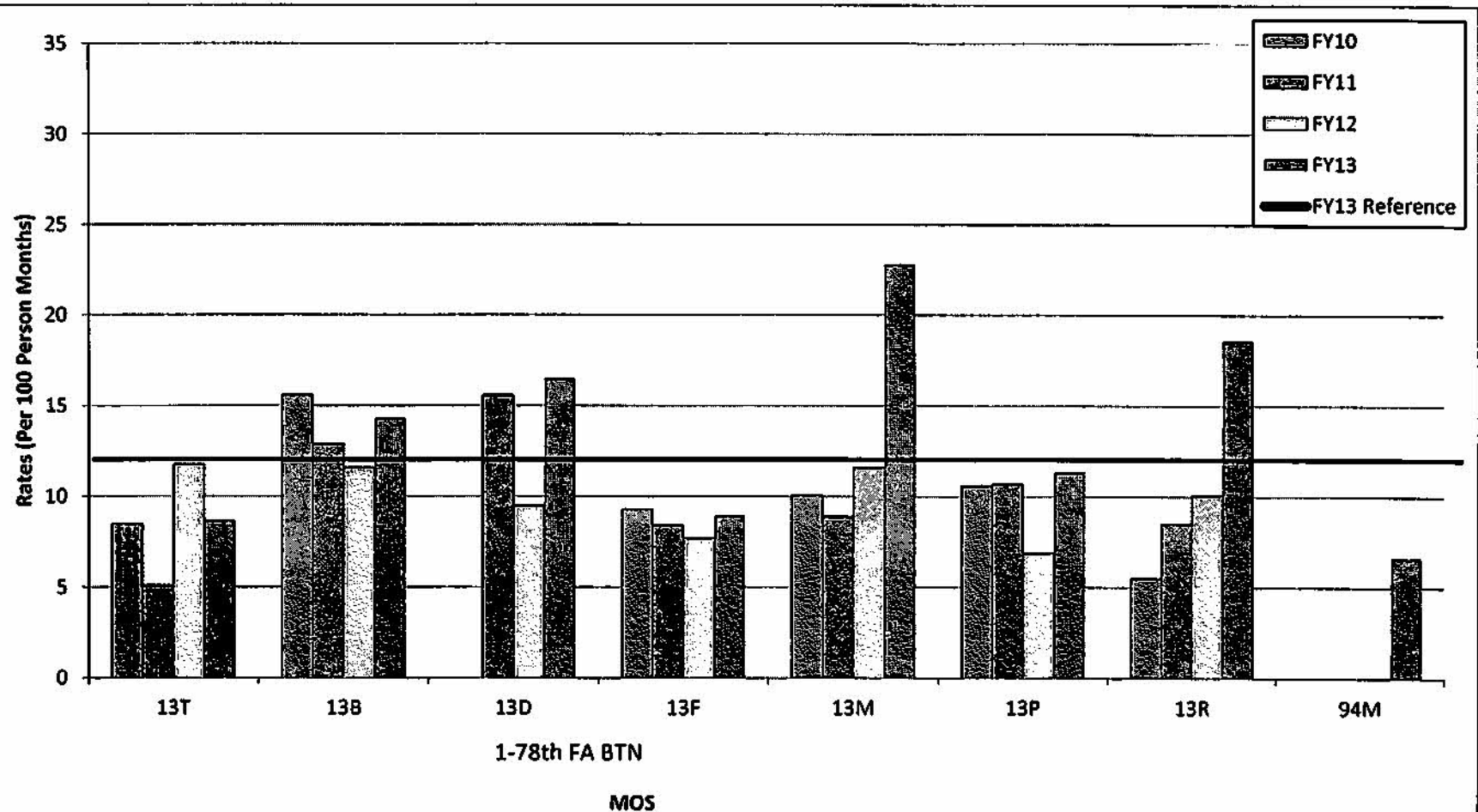

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Field Artillery AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS (Injuries per 100 person-months)

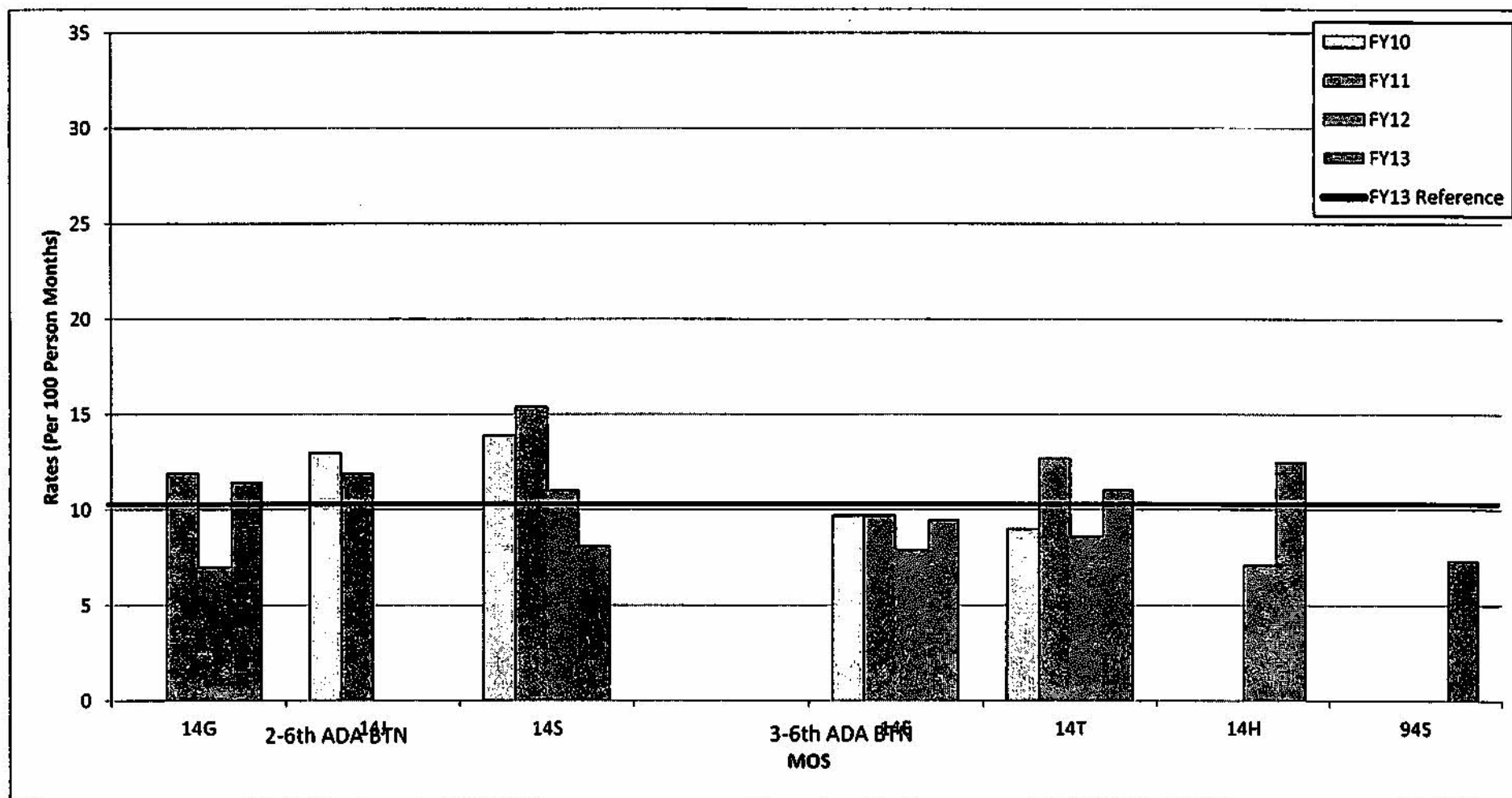


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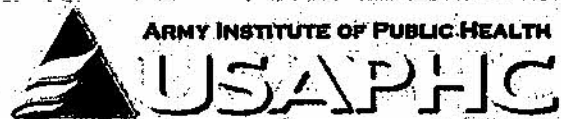


Air Defense Artillery AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS and Battalion (Injuries per 100 person-months)

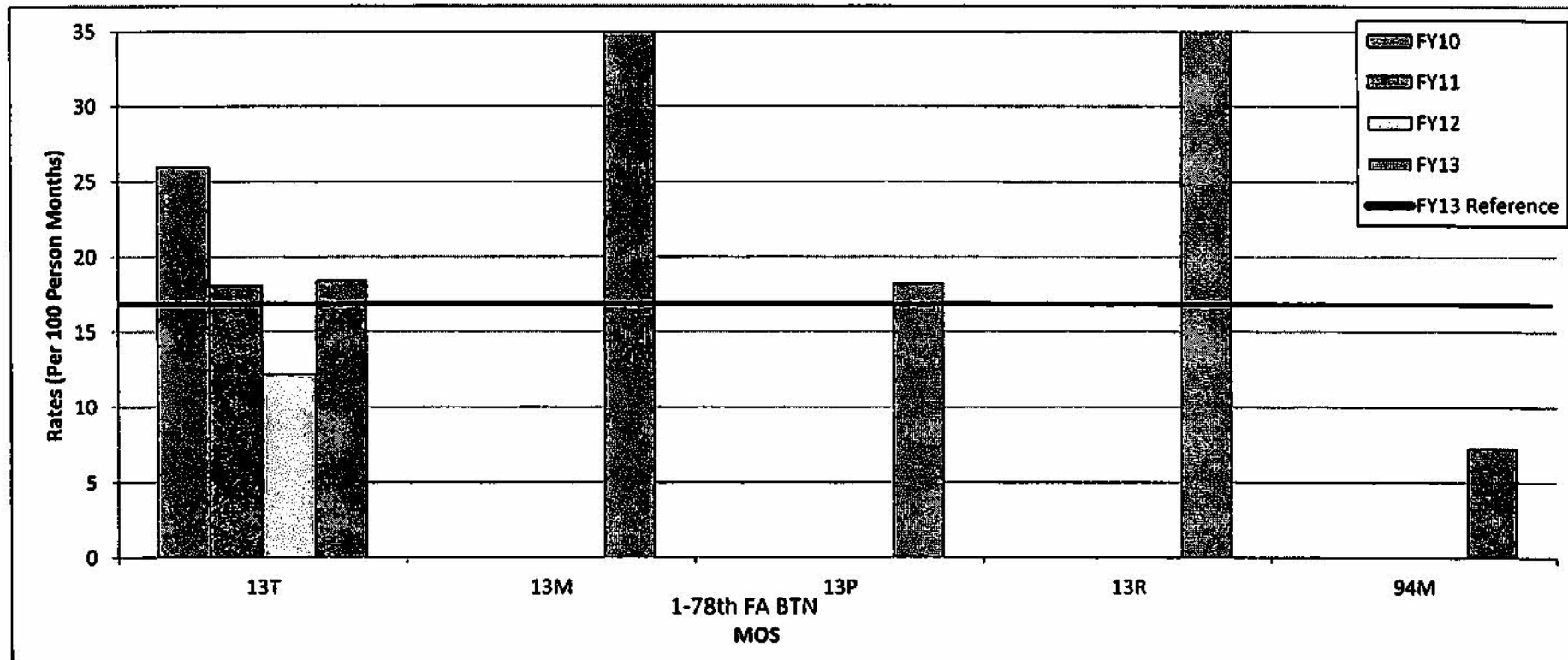


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Field Artillery AIT Women: Injury Rates for 13T (Injuries per 100 person-months)

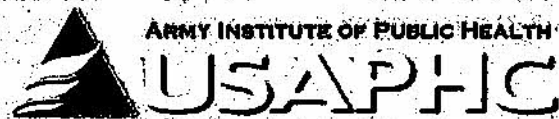

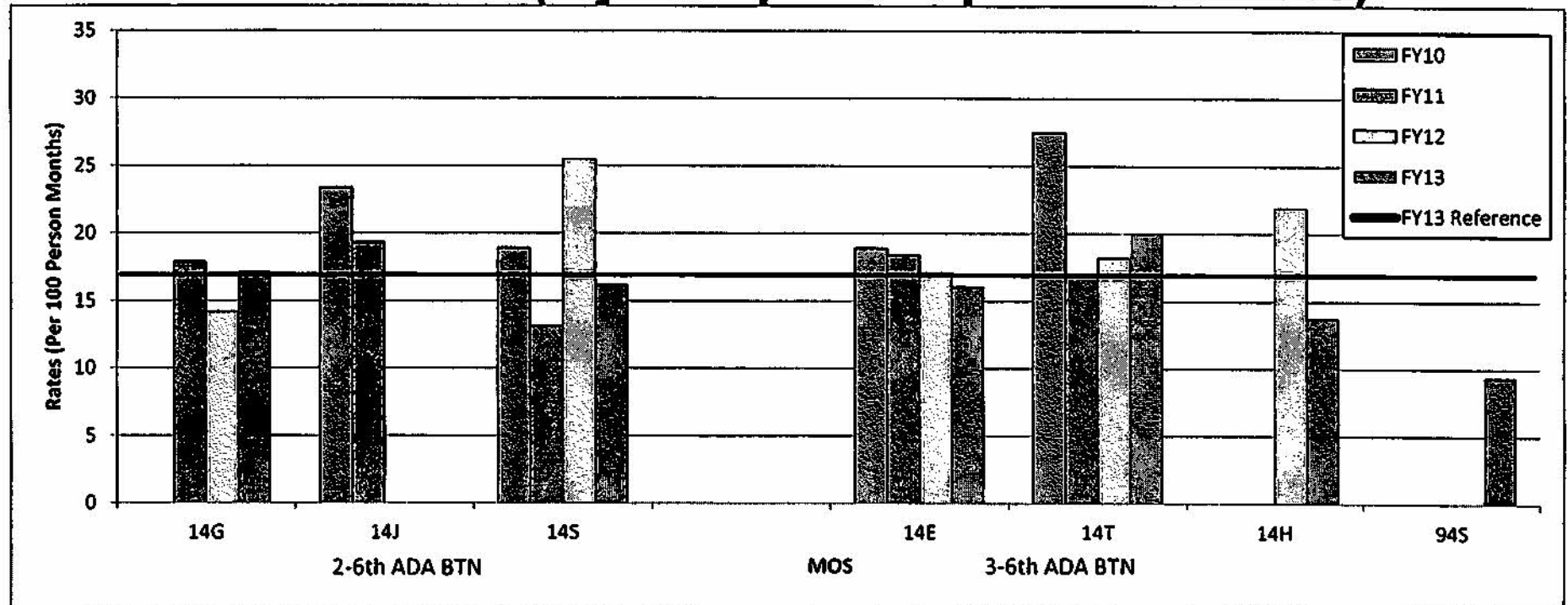

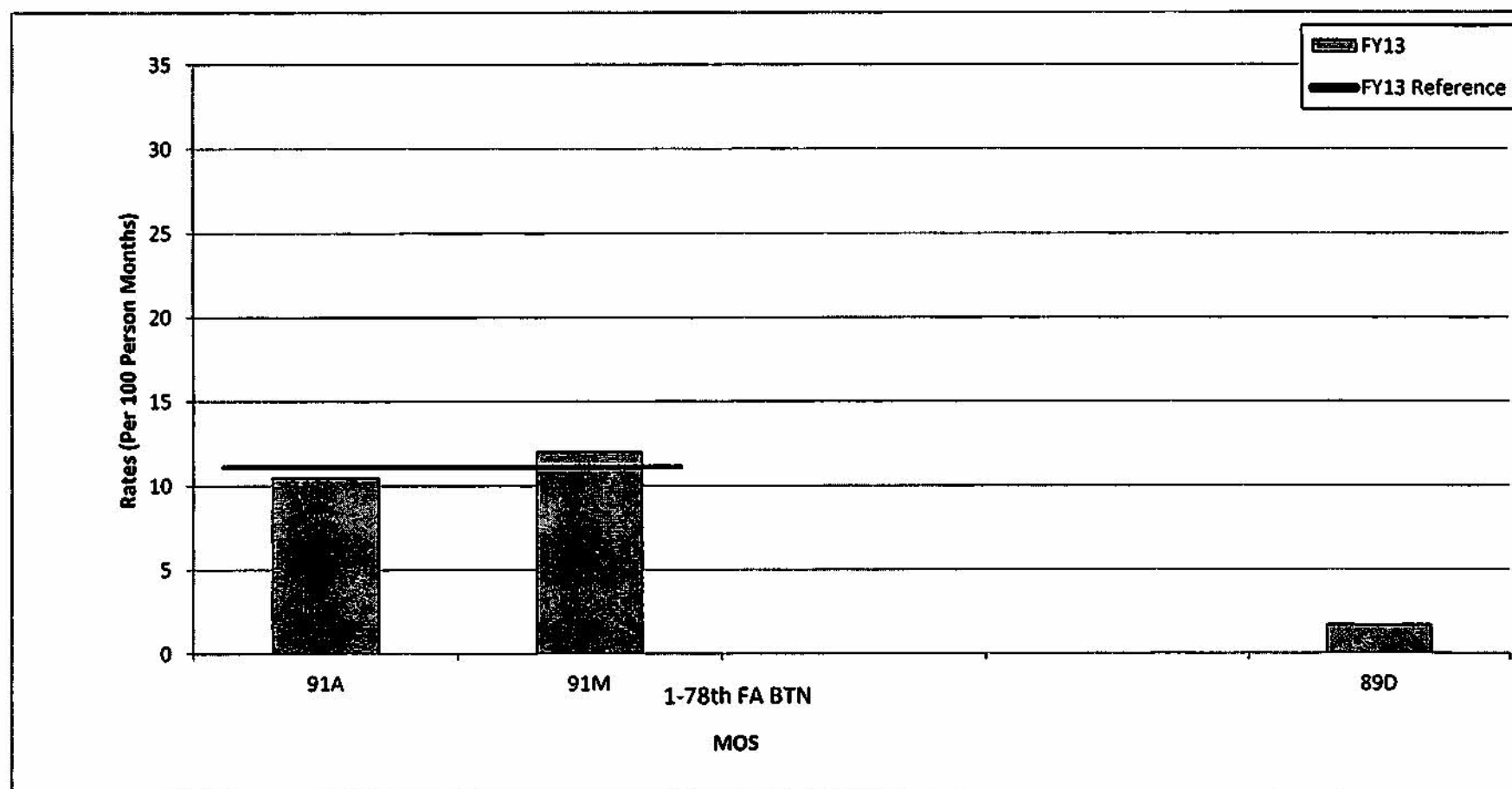

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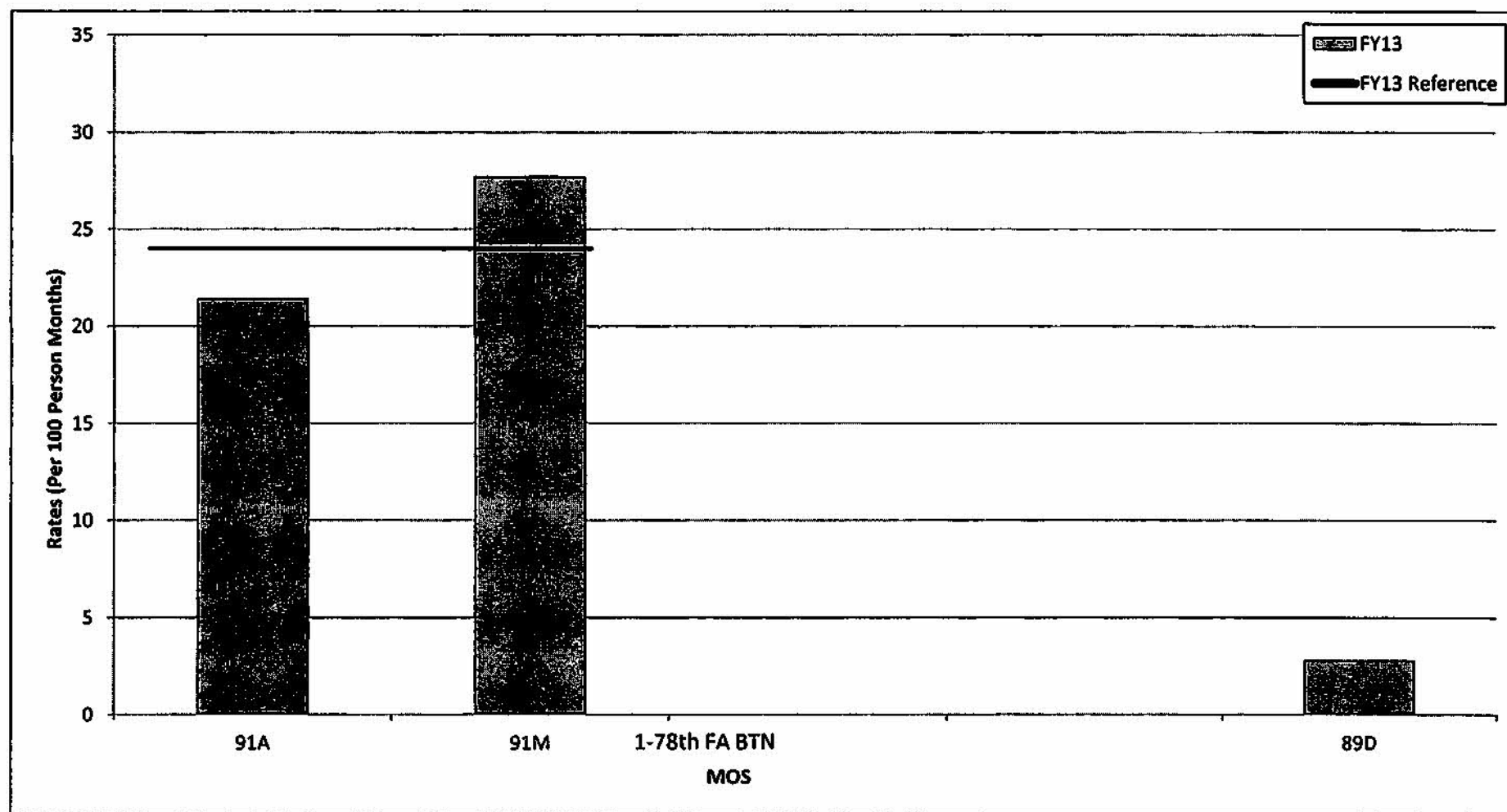
Armor and EOD AIT Men: Injury Rates by MOS and Battalion (Injuries per 100 person-months)
